## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE REQUIREMENT THAT HUNTERS WEAR BLAZE
- 3 ORANGE TO ENCOMPASS THE HUNTING OF OTHER TYPES OF GAME.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 113-291.8(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Any person hunting bear, deer, or wild boar, game animals other than foxes, 7 bobcats, raccoons, and opossum, or hunting upland game birds other than wild turkeys, 8 with the use of firearms, must wear a cap or hat on his head made of hunter orange 9 material or an outer garment of hunter orange visible from all sides. Hunter orange 10 material is a material that is a daylight fluorescent orange color.

This section does not apply to a landholder, his spouse, or children, who are hunting on land held by the landholder. <u>This subsection shall be enforced by warning ticket only</u> <u>until October 1, 1992, with respect to those hunting rabbit, squirrel, grouse, pheasant,</u>
