A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
2 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
3 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
4 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE
5 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain
9 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North
10 Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed herein for
11 each institution, and to authorize the financing of these said capital improvements
12 projects with funds available to the institutions and the Hospitals from gifts, grants,
13 receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of such funds,
14 but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State.

16 provided in Section 1 of this act are as follows:

39 Sec. 3. The Director of the Budget, provided the Director of the Budget may
40 consult with the Advisory Budget Commission, may, when in his opinion it is in the
41 best interest of the State to do so, and upon the request of The University of North
42 Carolina Board of Governors, authorize an increase or a decrease in the scope or a
43 change in the method of funding of any project authorized by this act.

44 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
