April 3, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE LOCAL 3 GOVERNMENT UNIT DELIVERING A PRISONER TO THE ALBEMARLE 4 DISTRICT JAIL TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR THAT PRISONER TO AND FROM THE FACILITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 153A-219(c) reads as rewritten: If a district confinement facility is established, or if one unit contracts to use the local confinement facility of another, the law-enforcement officers of the contracting units and the custodial personnel of the facility may unit that delivered a prisoner to the facility shall transport prisoners that prisoner to and from the facility." Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Albemarle District Jail facility in Elizabeth City and to Camden, Pasquotank, and Perquimans Counties, which place prisoners in that facility. 14 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
