A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF GOVERNMENT UNIT DELIVERING A PRISONER TO THE DISTRICT JAIL TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION FOR THAT I AND FROM THE FACILITY.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. G.S. 153A-219(c) reads as rewritten:  "(c) If a district confinement facility is established, or if one unit the local confinement facility of another, the law-enforcement officers of units and the custodial personnel of the facility may unit that delivered a facility shall transport prisoners—that prisoner to and from the facility.  Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Albemarle District Elizabeth City and to Camden, Pasquotank, and Perquimans Countied prisoners in that facility.  Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
