CHAPTER 371 HOUSE BILL 584

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT IN WHICH A PRISONER WAS ARRESTED TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE ALBEMARLE DISTRICT JAIL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-219(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) If a district confinement facility is established, or if one unit contracts to use the local confinement facility of another, the law-enforcement officers of the contracting units and the custodial personnel of the facility may <u>unit in which the prisoner was</u> <u>arrested shall</u> transport prisoners that prisoner to and from the facility. <u>facility for all</u> <u>purposes.</u>"

Sec. 2. This act applies only to the Albemarle District Jail facility in Elizabeth City and to Camden, Pasquotank, and Perquimans Counties, which place prisoners in that facility.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 24th day of June, 1991.
