AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY ASSESSMENTS UPON THE TURFGRASS AND FORAGE
INDUSTRIES TO GENERATE FUNDS FOR RESEARCH AND EDUCATION
CONCERNING THE USE OF TURFGRASS AND FORAGE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study the
issue of allowing producers and others in the turfgrass and forage industry to levy upon
themselves an assessment for the purpose of generating funds for research and
educational activities relating to the use of turfgrass and forage.
Sec. 2. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the
1992 Regular Session of the 1991 General Assembly.
Sec. 3. From the funds available to the General Assembly, the Legislative
Services Commission may allocate \$10,000 to the Legislative Research Commission for
the study of turfgrass and forage assessments.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1991.
