A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A COMMISSION TO STUDY THE CUMULATIVE
2 IMPACTS OF LEGISLATION AND REGULATION ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
3 RIGHTS IN THIS STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Private Property Rights Study Commission is created. The
7 Commission shall consist of 13 members to be appointed as follows:

- 8 (1) Three private landowners, one each from the mountains, the Piedmont,
9 and the coastal plains regions, to be appointed by the Governor;
- 10 (2) The Attorney General or his designee;
- 11 (3) The Secretary of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural
12 Resources, or his designee, and one other official of that department,
13 to be appointed by the Secretary;
- 14 (4) The Commissioner of Agriculture, or his designee;
- 15 (5) Three members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed by
16 the Speaker;
- 17 (6) Three members of the Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro
18 Tempore.

19 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro
20 Tempore of the Senate shall each designate one of their appointees to act as a
21 cochairman of the Commission.

22 Sec. 3. The Commission shall study the cumulative impacts of legislation
23 and regulation on the private property rights of the citizens of this State.

1 Sec. 4. The Commission shall submit a report of its findings and
2 recommendations to the 1993 General Assembly. Upon filing its report, the
3 Commission shall terminate.

4 Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
