A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO INSTALL TRAFFIC SIGNS
2 AND OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON ITS MUNICIPAL STREET
3 SYSTEM STREETS WHEN CONDITIONS REQUIRE TRAFFIC CONTROL
4 STANDARDS THAT ARE MORE STRINGENT THAN THOSE CONTAINED IN
5 THE UNIFORM MANUAL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. G.S. 136-30 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 "(b1) When safety or other traffic conditions exist that require additional traffic
10 control, a municipality may apply traffic control standards that are more stringent than
11 those contained in the Uniform Manual and may place traffic signs and other traffic
12 control devices to identify and enforce those more stringent standards."

13 Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Charlotte only.

14 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
