CONTRACTUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND THE LEGISLATIVE TUITION GRANT PROGRAM FOR PRIVATE AND INDEPENDENT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million two hundred one thousand nine hundred forty-two dollars (\$2,201,942) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to fund fully the State contractual Scholarship Program and the Legislative Tuition Grant Program for private and independent colleges and universities at the maximum rates established by Section 51 of Chapter 689 of the 1991 Session Laws. These rates provide a maximum of four hundred fifty dollars (\$450.00) per North Carolina student enrolled in each institution per year from the State Contractual Scholarship Program and a maximum of one thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$1,150) per North Carolina student enrolled in each institution per year from the Legislative Tuition Grant Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
