A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RESTORE THE AGRICULTURAL
FINANCE AUTHORITY BUDGET.

Whereas, the Agricultural Finance Authority has operated with annual onetime budget appropriations during the 1990-91 fiscal year to continue to provide services; and

Whereas, the Authority has made a number of loans during the 1989-91 biennium and currently has a backlog of applicants awaiting funding; and

Whereas, the Authority is providing a valuable service to certain farmers and agribusinesses who are unable to obtain credit at reasonable rates from other sources; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

21 22 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of \$215,804 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$214,965 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for operation of the North Carolina Agricultural Finance Authority. This appropriation shall become a part of the Department of Agriculture's continuation budget.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of \$204,627 for the 1991-92 fiscal year for the Reserve for Farm Loans of the North Carolina Agricultural Finance Authority, as a one-time appropriation.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
