- IN RELIANCE UPON DOCUMENTS NOTARIZED BY ATTORNEYS. 3
- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4
 - Section 1. G.S. 47-8 reads as rewritten:

"§ 47-8. Attorney in action not to probate papers therein. 6

No practicing attorney-at-law has power to administer any oaths to a person to any 7 paper-writing to be used in any legal proceedings in which he appears as attorney. 8

However, final judgments otherwise proper, entered in actions or proceedings in which 9

the complaints or any other documents were verified in violation of this section shall not 10

- be void or voidable." 11
 - Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
