7	Section 1. G.S. 47-8 is repealed.
8	Sec. 2. Article 1 of Chapter 47 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
9	a new section to read:
10	" <u>§ 47-8.1. Certain documents verified by attorneys validated.</u>
11	Final judgments otherwise proper, entered in actions or proceedings in which the
12	complaints or any other documents were verified in violation of G.S. 47-8 prior to its
13	repeal shall not be void or voidable."
14	Sec. 3. Chapter 10 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
15	section to read:
16	" <u>§ 10-18. Acts of notaries concerning certain deeds of trust validated.</u>
17	All deeds of trust recorded prior to January 1, 1991, in which the notary public was
18	named in the document as a trustee only are hereby validated."
19	Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.

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
