CHAPTER 764 SENATE BILL 607

AN ACT TO PERMIT CERTAIN COUNTIES TO USE PROPERTY TAX FUNDS FOR HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAMS ALREADY AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-149(c)(15a) reads as rewritten:

"(15a) Housing Rehabilitation. – To provide for <u>housing rehabilitation</u> programs authorized by G.S. 153A-376, including personnel costs related to <u>the planning and administration of housing rehabilitation programs authorized by G.S. 153A-376. <u>these programs</u>. This subdivision only applies applies only to counties with a population of 400,000 or more, according to the most recent decennial federal census."</u>

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 15th day of June, 1992.
