Section 1. G.S. 15A-931(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Except as provided in G.S. 20-138.4, the prosecutor may dismiss any charges 7 stated in a criminal pleading <u>including those deferred for prosecution</u> by entering an oral 8 dismissal in open court before or during the trial, or by filing a written dismissal with 9 the clerk at any time. The clerk must record the dismissal entered by the prosecutor and 10 note in the case file whether a jury has been impaneled or evidence has been 11 introduced."

12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
