6 —-REVENUE ESTIMATES/ANNUAL BUDGET

Section 1. The Executive Budget Act, Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, is amended by adding the following new section:

"§ 143-2.1. Growth in General Fund operating expenditures limited.

- (a) In preparing the budget for a fiscal year, the Governor shall not propose a percentage increase in operating expenditures paid out of the General Fund which exceeds the growth in State personal income for the most recent 12-month period for which State personal income data has been compiled by the Bureau of Economic Analysis of the United States Department of Commerce.
- (b) In enacting the budget for a fiscal year, the General Assembly shall not enact a percentage increase in operating expenditures paid out of the General Fund which exceeds the growth in State personal income for the most recent 12-month period for which State personal income data has been compiled by the Bureau of Economic Analysis of the United States Department of Commerce."
- Sec. 2. This act becomes effective for budgets beginning with the budget for fiscal year 1992-93.
