- 2 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA LICENSURE
- 3 REQUIREMENTS FROM OUT-OF-STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
 4 EDUCATION OPERATING ON MILITARY BASES.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 116-15(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Post-secondary Degree Activity within the Military. – To the extent that an
institution undertakes post-secondary degree activity on the premises of military posts
or reservations located in this <u>State-State</u>, for military personnel stationed on active duty
there, or their dependents, the institution shall be exempt from the licensure requirements
of this section."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
