A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR NORTH CAROLINA HEAD START

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND SERVICES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Economic Opportunity, the sum of \$3,375,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to provide 135 new Head Start classrooms.

- Sec. 2. Of the funds appropriated in the Current Operations Appropriations Act of 1991 to the Department of Public Education for dropout prevention for the 1991-92 fiscal year, \$1,700,000 shall be transferred to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Economic Opportunity, to equip Head Start programs with interactive laser disc computer hardware.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Economic Opportunity, the sum of \$592,00 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to provide computer software for Head Start programs. Software provided with these funds shall include applications covering the following:
 - (1) Literacy;
 - (2) Prevention of child abuse and neglect;
- 19 (3) Decision making;
- 20 (4) Prevention of substance abuse; and
- 21 (5) Nutrition.
