A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OSHA DIVISION OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Occupational Safety and Health Division of the Department of Labor the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide for the funding of 12 positions for the Education and Training Bureau; 10 positions for the Consultative Services Bureau; seven positions for the Compliance Bureau; three positions for the Management Information and Evaluation Bureau; and two positions for the Occupational Safety and Health Review Board, plus additional funding for OSHA Review Board hearing examiners.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
