A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT ENABLING THE COUNTY OF DAVIDSON TO ESTABLISH AN
 AIRPORT AUTHORITY FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF
 AIRPORT FACILITIES IN THE COUNTY OF DAVIDSON FOR THE CITIZENS
 OF DAVIDSON COUNTY.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is hereby created in the "Davidson County Airport 8 Authority" (for brevity hereinafter referred to as the "Airport Authority"), which shall 9 be a body both corporate and politic, having the powers and jurisdiction hereinafter 10 enumerated and such other and additional powers as shall be conferred upon it by future 11 acts of the General Assembly.

12 Sec. 2. The Airport Authority shall consist of five members who shall be resident voters of Davidson County and who shall be appointed by the Davidson County 13 Board of Commissioners, and who shall meet quarterly at a place determined by the 14 Chairman of the Airport Authority. The Airport Authority shall consist of five members 15 who shall be appointed to staggered terms of four years by the Davidson County Board 16 of Commissioners. The initial terms of office of the members of the Airport Authority 17 18 shall be as follows: two members to be appointed to a term of four years, three members to be appointed to a term of two years. Thereafter, all terms shall be four 19 years. After the initial term, any member may be reappointed to two more successive 20 21 terms, after which that member may not be reappointed to the Airport Authority except 22 after the lapse of two years following the most recent term served. In the event the Davidson County Board of Commissioners should appoint one of the members of that 23 Board as a member of the Airport Authority, the membership shall not constitute double 24

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officeholding within the meaning of Article VI, Section 9 of the Constitution of North 1 2 Carolina. Each of the members and their successors so appointed shall take and 3 subscribe before the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners for the County of Davidson, 4 an oath of office and file the same with the County Commissioners of Davidson County. Any member of the Airport Authority may be removed, for cause, by the Davidson 5 6 County Board of Commissioners. The Davidson County Board of Commissioners, 7 may, at the request of the Airport Authority, increase membership to no more than nine 8 members or decrease the membership to no less than five members. The Davidson 9 County Board of Commissioners shall consult with the Airport Authority in filling 10 vacancies on the Airport Authority. 11 Sec. 3. The members shall, for the purpose of doing business, constitute a 12 Board of Directors, which shall adopt suitable bylaws for its management. The 13 members of the Board shall receive compensation or per diem by unanimous agreement 14 of the Board of County Commissioners. Members shall be allowed and paid their actual 15 traveling expenses incurred in transacting the business and at the instance of the Airport 16 Authority. 17 Sec. 4. The Airport Authority shall constitute a body both corporate and 18 politic, and may: 19 (1) Purchase, acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip, 20 improve, maintain, operate, and regulate the Davidson County Airport 21 for the use of airplanes and other aircraft, and all facilities incidental to 22 the operation of such airport, within the limits of Davidson County; and for any of such purposes, to purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease, 23 24 and/or operate real or personal property; 25 (2)Purchase real or personal property; (3) Sue or be sued in the name of the Airport Authority, make contracts 26 27 necessary for the exercise of the powers of the Airport Authority, and acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, any existing lease, leasehold 28 29 right, or other interest in any existing airport located in Davidson 30 County; 31 (4) Charge and collect reasonable and adequate fees, royalties, rents, or 32 other charges for the use of the property owned, leased, or otherwise controlled or operated by the Airport Authority or for services 33 34 rendered in the operation thereof; 35 (5) Make all reasonable rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the 36 proper maintenance, use, operation, and control of any airport or airport facilities owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by the Airport 37 38 Authority; to provide penalties for the violation of such rules and 39 regulations; provided the rules and regulations and penalties be not in 40 conflict with the laws of the State of North Carolina and the rules and regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration; 41 42 (6) Sell, lease, or otherwise dispose of any property, real or personal, belonging to the Airport Authority, but no sale of real property shall be 43

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1		made without the approval of the Board of County Commissioners of
2		Davidson County and the Federal Aviation Administration;
3	(7)	Purchase such insurance as the Airport Authority shall deem
4		necessary;
5	(8)	Deposit or invest and reinvest any of its funds as provided by the Local
6		Government Finance Act, as it may be amended from time to time, for
7		the deposit or investment of unit funds;
8	(9)	Operate, own, lease, control, regulate, or grant to others a lease; not to
9		exceed 25 years, to operate on any airport premises, restaurants, snack
10		bars, and vending machines, food and beverage dispensing outlets,
11		rental car services, catering services, novelty shops, insurance sales,
12		advertising media, merchandising outlets, motels, hotels, barber shops,
13		automobile parking and storage facilities, automobile service stations,
14		garage service facilities, motion pictures, personal service
15		establishments, and all other types of facilities as may be directly or
16		indirectly related to the maintenance and furnishing to the general
17	(10)	public of a complete air terminal installation;
18 19	(10)	Possess the same exemptions in respect to payment of taxes and license fees, as provided for municipal corporations by the laws of the
20		State of North Carolina;
20	(11)	Issue revenue bonds pursuant to Article 5 of Chapter 159 of the
22	(11)	General Statutes;
23	(12)	Have all the same power and authority granted to cities and counties
24	(1-)	pursuant to Chapter 63 of the General Statutes; or
25	(13)	Have a corporate seal which may be altered at will.
26		5. Any lands acquired, owned, controlled, and occupied by the Airport
27		, and are hereby declared to be acquired, owned, controlled, and
28	occupied for a public purpose.	
29	Sec. 6. The Airport Authority shall make an annual report to the Davidson	
30	County Board of Commissioners setting forth in detail the operations and transactions	
31	conducted by it pursuant to this act. The Airport Authority shall be regarded as the	
32	corporate instrumentality and agent for Davidson County for the purpose of operating,	
33	maintaining, and developing airport facilities in Davidson County, but it shall not have	
34	the power to pledge the credit of Davidson County or any subdivision thereof, or to	
35	impose any obligation upon Davidson County or any subdivision thereof, except and	
36	when such power is expressly granted by statute.	
37	Sec. 7. All rights and powers given and granted to the counties or	
38	municipalities by the statutes of North Carolina, which may now be in effect or enacted	
39	in the future relating to the development, regulation, and control of county airports and	
40	the regulation of aircraft, are vested in the Airport Authority, and Davidson County will delegate its newers under these sets to the Airport Authority and the Airport Authority	
41 42	delegate its powers under those acts to the Airport Authority and the Airport Authority	
42 43	shall control, regulate, and provide for the development of aviation in Davidson County. Sec. 8. The Airport Authority may employ agents, engineers, attorneys, and

1 and useful in carrying out the provisions of this act. Members of the Airport Authority

2 shall not be personally liable, in any manner, for their acts as members of the Airport

3 Authority, except for misfeasance or malfeasance.

4 Sec. 9. If any one or more sections, clauses, sentences, or parts of this act 5 shall be adjudged invalid, that judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the 6 remaining provisions thereof, but that judgment shall be confined in its operation to the 7 specific provisions held invalid, and the inapplicability of invalidity of any section, 8 clause, sentence, or part of this act in one or more instances or circumstances shall not 9 be taken to affect or prejudice in any way to the applicability or validity in any other 10 instance of that section, clause, sentence, or part.

11 Sec. 10. This act is effective upon ratification.
