A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO INCREASE THE RETIREMENT FORMULA WITH A INCREASE TO RETIREES OF THE TEACHERS' AND STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 135-5(b14) reads as rewritten:  "(b14) Service Retirement Allowance of Members Retiring on a subsection (a) above, on or after July 1, 1994. — Upon retirement from service in subsection (a) above, on or after July 1, 1993, but before July 1, 1994, receive the following service retirement allowance:  (1) A member who is a law enforcement officer or an eligenforcement officer shall receive a service retirement computed as follows:  a. "(xx) Increase in Allowance as to Persons on Retirement Rolls as of June 1, 1994. — From and after July 1, 1994, the retirement allowance to or on account of beneficiaries on the retirement rolls as of June 1, 1994, shall be increased by one and two-tenths of one percent (1.2%) of the allowance payable on June 1, 1994. This allowance shall be calculated on the allowance payable and in effect on June 30, 1994, so as not to be
