A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NATIONAL ENVIROTHON, A  
2 COMPETITIVE PROBLEM-SOLVING EVENT FOR HIGH SCHOOL  
3 STUDENTS FROM ACROSS THE UNITED STATES THAT TESTS THE  
4 STUDENTS' KNOWLEDGE OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THAT WILL  
5 BE HELD IN ASHEVILLE THIS YEAR.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of  
8 Soil and Water Conservation, Department of Environment, Health, and Natural  
9 Resources the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year  
10 for the costs of North Carolina serving as host of the National Envirothon to be held in  
11 Asheville this year. The National Envirothon is a competitive, five-day program for  
12 high school students from across the United States that tests the students' knowledge of  
13 natural resources and cultivates a desire to learn about our environment.

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
