2	AN ACT TO MAKE CLARIFYING, CONFORMING, AND TECHNICAL
3	CHANGES TO VARIOUS LAWS RELATING TO ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH,
4	AND NATURAL RESOURCES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
5	ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 7A-29(a) reads as rewritten:
8	"(a) From any final order or decision of the North Carolina Utilities Commission
9	not governed by subsection (b) of this section, the Department of Human Resources
10	under G.S. 131E-188(b), the Commissioner of Banks under Articles 17, 18, 18A, and 21
11	of Chapter 53 of the General Statutes, the Administrator of Savings and Loans under
12	Article 3A of Chapter 54B of the General Statutes, the North Carolina Industrial
13	Commission, the North Carolina State Bar under G.S. 84-28, the Property Tax
14	Commission under G.S. 105-290 and G.S. 105-342, the Commissioner of Insurance
15	under G.S. 58-2-80, or the Secretary of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources
16	under G.S. 104E-6.2, 104E-6.2 or G.S. 130A-293, appeal as of right lies directly to the
17	Court of Appeals."
18	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
