A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT STANLY COUNTY FROM PROVISIONS OF THE NORTH
CAROLINA STATE BUILDING CODE THAT REQUIRE BUILDING
INSPECTION DEPARTMENTS TO REVIEW RESIDENTIAL PLANS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 387 of the 1993 Sessions Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Section 1. Provisions of the North Carolina State Building Code requiring county
building inspection departments to review residential plans do not apply to ~~Mecklenburg
County.~~ Mecklenburg and Stanly Counties."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
