- 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE TO DONATE UNCLAIMED
- 3 BICYCLES TO CHARITY.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding Article 2 of Chapter 15 of the General Statutes, 5 Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, or any provision of the city charter, 6 whenever unclaimed bicycles are in the possession of the police department, no earlier 7 than 30 days after the date of publication of the notice required by G.S. 15-12, the city 8 may donate the bicycles to a charitable organization exempt under section 501(c)(3) of 9 the Internal Revenue Code rather than selling the bicycles as provided by law. In such 10 case, the notice required by G.S. 15-12 shall state the intended disposition of the 11 bicycles if they are not claimed. 12 Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Asheville only.
