1 (5) Be authorized and empowered to pay all necessary costs and expenses 2 involved and incident to the formation and organization of said 3 Authority, and incident to the administration and operation thereof, and to pay all other costs and expenses reasonably necessary or 4 5 expedient in carrying out and accomplishing the purposes of this 6 Article: 7 Be authorized and empowered to apply for and accept loans and grants (6) 8 of money from any federal agency or the State of North Carolina or 9 any political subdivision thereof or from any public or private sources 10 available for any and all of the purposes authorized in this Article, and to expend the same in accordance with the directions and requirements 11 12 attached thereto, or imposed thereon by any such federal agency, the 13 State of North Carolina, or any political subdivision thereof, or any 14 public or private lender or donor, and to give such evidences of 15 indebtedness as shall be required, provided, however, that no 16 indebtedness of any kind incurred or created by the Authority shall 17 constitute an indebtedness of the State of North Carolina, or any 18 political subdivisions thereof, and no such indebtedness shall involve 19 or be secured by the faith, credit or taxing power of the State of North Carolina, or any political subdivision thereof: 20 21 **(7)** Be authorized and empowered to act as agent for the United States of 22 America, or any agency, department, corporation, or instrumentality 23 thereof, in any matter coming within the purposes or powers of the 24 Authority; 25 (8) Have power to adopt, alter or repeal bylaws and rules governing the manner in which its business may be transacted and in which the 26 27 power granted to it may be enjoyed, and may provide for the appointment of such committees, and the functions thereof, as the 28 29 Authority may deem necessary or expedient in facilitating its business; 30 Have power to assess and collect reasonable fees for its services or for (8a) the use of its facilities; 31 32 (9) Be authorized and empowered to do any and all other acts and things 33 in this Article authorized or required to be done, whether or not 34 included in the general powers in this section mentioned; and 35 (10)Be authorized and empowered to do any and all things necessary to

accomplish the purposes of this Article."
