A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE HOSPITAL- AND HOME-BASED INSTRUCTIONAL  
2 SERVICES TO CHILDREN OTHER THAN CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL  
3 NEEDS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

7 "(36) To Provide Hospital- and Home-Based Instructional  
8 Services to Students Other Than Students With Special  
9 Needs. – Each administrative unit shall provide hospital- and  
10 home-based instructional services to students, other than  
11 students with special needs, who because of illness or  
12 accidents require extended recuperation at home or an  
13 extended stay in a hospital."

14 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
15 Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of one million  
16 five hundred forty-nine thousand nine hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$1,549,969) for the  
17 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred seventy-nine thousand two  
18 hundred nineteen dollars (\$1,579,219) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide hospital-  
19 and home-based instructional services to children other than children with special needs.  
20 These funds shall be provided to local school administrative units on a reimbursement  
21 basis.

22 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
