Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 1019 of the 1987 Session Laws, as amended by Section 3 of Chapter 456 and Section 6.1 of Chapter 594, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

- "Sec. 3. This act applies to the Towns of Holden Beach and Long-Beach, Long Beach, and Sunset Beach only, but as to the Town of Holden Beach, Section 1 of this act applies only to areas within the corporate limits of the Town as of June 26, 1989, and as to Sunset Beach, Section 1 of this act applies only to areas on the island."
- Sec. 2. (a) Section 1 of Chapter 1019, Session Laws of 1987, as amended by Chapter 456, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

"Section 1. Except as provided in Section 2 of this act or an ordinance adopted by the town council and approved in a referendum as provided by Section 2.1 of this act, no building erected within the corporate limits of any town, as defined in G.S. 160A-1, after the effective date of this act may have a height in excess of 35 feet above ground level. feet, as height is defined in the town code of ordinances."

- (b) This section applies only to the Town of Sunset Beach.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
