8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
9	Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction by certain		
10	constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North		
11	Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects, or supplements		
12	to capital improvements projects, listed in this act for the respective institutions, and		
13	authorize the financing of these projects or project supplements with funds available to

16	any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from the General		
17	Fund of the State.
