- 5 Section 1. Section 3.3(a) of the Charter of the Town of Salemburg, being 6 Chapter 104 of the 1967 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) The Mayor shall serve for a term of <u>two-four</u> years, beginning the day and 8 hour of the organizational meeting following his election, as established by ordinance in 9 accordance with <u>this Charter; G.S. 160A-68;</u> provided, he shall serve until his successor 10 is duly elected and qualifies."
