A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR HUNTING AND TRAPPING FOXES IN3 PENDER COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open 6 season for taking foxes with weapons or traps from January 1 through January 31 of 7 each year. During this season, all leghold traps set on dry land with solid anchor shall 8 have at least one swivel in the trap chain and no leghold traps larger than size one and 9 one-half may be used.

- 10 Sec. 2. A season bag limit of 30 applies in the aggregate to all foxes taken 11 during the weapons and trapping season established in Section 1 of this act.
- 12 Sec. 3. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of 13 foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.
 - Sec. 4. This act applies only to Pender County.
- 15 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1994.
