A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H CAMP PROGRAM.

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H camps are owned by the State, or deeded to an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and

Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of these facilities; and

Whereas, each year, these facilities provide educational and recreational services to more than 10,000 North Carolina families representative of the State's population; and

Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000 contributed by citizen volunteers; and

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund, Inc., at North Carolina State University needs funds to operate the 4-H camps; and

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund, Inc., agrees to match the State funds needed each year with funds from the private sector; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used by the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund, Inc., at North Carolina State University for operating expenses and the general support of its 4-H camp programs, provided these funds are matched on

- 1 the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State

- 3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
