A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR RAPI

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR RAPE CRISIS AND SEXUAL ASSAULT PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, North Carolina Council for Women, the sum of one million seven hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$1,725,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million seven hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$1,725,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the prevention of sexual assault and the continuation and development of rape crisis and sexual assault programs within the State, to be allocated as follows:

- (1) Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year shall be used for a grant-in-aid to the North Carolina Coalition Against Sexual Assault, Incorporated;
- One million five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$1,560,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and one million five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$1,560,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year shall be evenly divided and used as grants-in-aid of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) each year of the biennium for the operation of each of the 52 rape crisis/sexual assault programs in operation on January 1, 1993, and providing a 24-hour crisis line, community education, victim advocacy, support services, and other services;
