A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE FAMILY SUPPORT NETWORK'S
PARENT TO PARENT SUPPORT PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the Parent To Parent Support Programs affiliated with the Family Support Network of North Carolina, a project located in the Division of Community Pediatrics at the University of North Carolina School of Medicine at Chapel Hill. The Parent To Parent Support Programs are community-based parent to parent support programs throughout the State for families with developmental disabilities, prematurity, or chronic illness. These funds shall be used to expand existing Parent To Parent Programs, develop new programs, purchase computer equipment, and provide support to the Family Support Network's central office and staff.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
