SENATE BILL 581

Short Title: Home-Based Instruction/Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE HOSPITAL- AND HOME-BASED INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES TO CHILDREN OTHER THAN CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

" (36) To Provide Hospital- and Home-Based Instructional Services to Students Other Than Students With Special Needs. – Each administrative unit shall provide hospital- and home-based instructional services to students, other than students with special needs, who because of illness or accidents require extended recuperation at home or an extended stay in a hospital."

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of one million five hundred forty-nine thousand nine hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$1,549,969) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred seventy-nine thousand two hundred nineteen dollars (\$1,579,219) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide hospital- and home-based instructional services to children other than children with special needs. These funds shall be provided to local school administrative units on a reimbursement basis.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
