6	Section 1. Part B of Article 6 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is
7	amended by adding a new section to read:
8	"§ 131E-131. Nursing homes charged for certain non-emergency medical services
9	<u>calls.</u>
10	The Department shall ensure that nursing homes placing non-emergency calls for
11	medical services are charged and pay for the ambulance fees."
12	Sec. 2. Article 1 of Chapter 131D of the General Statutes is amended by
13	adding a new section to read:
14	"§ 131D-7. Domiciliary care facilities charged for certain non-emergency medical
15	<u>services calls.</u>
16	The Department shall ensure that domiciliary care facilities placing non-emergency
17	calls for medical services are charged and pay for the ambulance fees."
18	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to calls for
19	medical services made on or after that date.
