A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PROVIDE LIFE-SUSTAINING MEDICATION FOR ELIGIBLE PERSONS INFECTED WITH HIV.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Adult Health, the sum of three hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$388,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$388,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide life-sustaining medications for medically indigent, non-Medicaid eligible people infected with the human immunodeficiency virus, as defined in rules adopted by the Commission for Health Services.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
