- National Red Cross Regulations and Procedures.
- 'Certified disaster service volunteer' means a person who has completed the necessary training for and been certified as a disaster service specialist by the American National Red Cross.
 - "§ 166A-32. Disaster service volunteer leave.

An employee of a State agency who is a certified disaster service volunteer of the American Red Cross may be granted leave from his work with pay for a time not to

exceed 15 work days in any 12-month period to participate in specialized disaster relief 1 services for the American Red Cross. To be granted leave, the request for the services 2 3 of that employee must come from the American Red Cross. The decision to grant the employee leave rests in the sole discretion of the employing State agency. Employees 4 5 granted leave pursuant to this Article shall not lose seniority, pay, vacation time, sick 6 time, or earned overtime accumulation. The State agency shall compensate an employee granted leave under this article at the regular rate of pay for those regular work hours during which the employee is absent from his work. Leave under this act shall be granted only for services related to a disaster occurring within the State of 9 10 North Carolina."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
