- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 section to read:

7 "<u>§ 20-171.3. Clinging to motor vehicles prohibited.</u>

8 (a) No person riding on any bicycle, moped, coaster, roller skates, in-line skates,

9 skateboard, sled, or toy vehicle shall attach himself or what he is riding to any motor
10 vehicle while on a roadway.

11 (b) This section shall not prohibit attaching a bicycle trailer or bicycle semitrailer

- 12 to a bicycle if that trailer or semitrailer has been designed for attachment to a bicycle."
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
