2	AN ACT TO CHANGE THE LAW REGARDING HOSPITAL FACILITIES TO
3	OFFER HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN BRANCH FACILITIES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 131E-14.1 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 131E-14.1. Branch facilities.
7	Notwithstanding anything in this Article, any county-municipality organized under
8	the provisions of this Article-Part or Part C may erect, remodel, enlarge, purchase,
9	finance, and operate branches and related facilities within this State but outside the
10	boundaries of the county subject to the following limitations:
11	(1) No moneys derived from the exercise by the owning <u>county municipality of</u>
12	its power of taxation shall be expended on facilities located outside its boundaries;
13	(2) No moneys derived from the issuance by the owning <u>county-municipality</u> of
14	its bonds or notes shall be expended on facilities located outside its boundaries;
15	(3) The owning <u>county</u> <u>municipality</u> shall not possess the power of eminent
16	domain or have the right of condemnation with respect to hospital facilities located
17	outside its boundaries. boundaries; and
18	(4) The power conferred on counties by G.S. 153A-169 and G.S. 153A-170 to
19	adopt ordinances regulating the use of county-owned property and parking on county-
20	owned property shall not extend to hospital facilities located outside its boundaries
21	unless the board of commissioners of the county in which the facility is located shall by
22	resolution permit any such ordinance to be applicable within its jurisdiction; jurisdiction.

- 1 (5) The owning county shall not be deemed liable, by virtue of operating hospital
- facilities outside its boundaries, for the cost of medical care of paupers who are legal
 residents of some other county;
- 4 (6) The authority granted by this section may not be exercised in any county that
- 5 has within its borders four or more incorporated municipalities which qualify to receive
- 6 funds under G.S. 136-41.2."

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Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
