2	AN ACT TO ALLOW CRAVEN COUNTY AND THE CITIES OF NEW BERN AND
3	HAVELOCK TO DONATE UNCLAIMED BICYCLES TO CHARITY.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 650 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by
6	Chapter 106 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
7	"Sec. 2. This act applies to the Cities of Asheville Asheville, Havelock, New Bern,
8	and Hendersonville only."
9	Sec. 2. (a)Notwithstanding Article 2 of Chapter 15 of the General Statutes or Article
10	12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, whenever unclaimed bicycles are in the
11	possession of the sheriff department, no earlier than 30 days after the date of publication
12	of the notice required by G.S. 15-12, the sheriff may donate the bicycles to a charitable
13	organization exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code rather than
14	selling the bicycles as provided by law. In such case, the notice required by G.S. 15-12
15	shall state the intended disposition of the bicycles if they are not claimed. \blacklozenge
16	(b) This section applies to Craven County only.
17	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
