5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 90-411 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 90-411. Record copy fee.
8	A health care provider may charge a reasonable fee to cover the costs incurred in
9	searching, handling, copying, and mailing medical records to the patient or the patient's
10	designated representative. The maximum fee shall be fifty seventy-five cents (50ϕ) (75ϕ)
11	per page, provided that the health care provider may impose a minimum fee of up to ten
12	twelve dollars (\$10.00), (\$12.00) inclusive of copying costs. If requested by the patient or
13	the patient's designated representative, nothing herein shall limit a reasonable
14	professional fee charged by a physician for the review and preparation of a narrative
15	summary of the patient's medical record. This section shall only apply with respect to
16	liability claims for personal injury, except that charges for medical records and reports
17	related to claims under Article 1 of Chapter 97 of the General Statutes shall be governed
18	by the fees established by the North Carolina Industrial Commission pursuant to G.S. 97-
19	26.4."
