The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 58-3-152. Excess liability policies; uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage. With respect to personal and commercial excess or umbrella liability policy forms or coverage, an insurer may limit or exclude coverage for uninsured motorist coverage set forth in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(3) and underinsured motorist coverage set forth in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(4)." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1996, and applies to policies

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issued or renewed on or after that date.
