

1 (c) The city manager shall have the powers and duties described in ~~North~~
2 ~~Carolina General Statute~~ G.S. 160A-148, including any other duties that
3 the Board of Commissioners may require or authorize.

4 (d) The city manager shall have the power to appoint, suspend, and remove
5 all officers, department heads, and employees in the administrative
6 service of the City of Havelock not elected by the people and whose
7 appointment or removal is not otherwise provided by law, except the
8 city attorney, in accordance with such general personnel rules,
9 regulations, policies, and ordinances as the board of commissioners may
10 adopt. Notwithstanding the contrary provisions of G.S. 105-349, the
11 city manager may appoint and remove the tax collector for the City of
12 Havelock, and the tax collector shall serve under the direction and at the
13 will of the city manager."

14 Sec. 2. All existing ordinances, resolutions, and other provisions of the City of
15 Havelock not inconsistent with the provisions of this act shall continue in effect until
16 repealed or amended.

17 Sec. 3. Whenever a reference is made in this act to a particular provision of the
18 General Statutes, and such provision is later amended, superseded, or recodified, the
19 reference shall be deemed amended to refer to the amended general statute, or to the
20 general statute which most clearly corresponds to the statutory provision which is
21 superseded or recodified.

22 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
