A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW EDGEcombe, GREENE, JACKSON, AND MADISON COUNTIES TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR USE BY THEIR COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 153A-158.1(e), as amended by Chapter 17 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"(e) Scope. - This section applies to Ashe, Avery, Bladen, Brunswick, Cabarrus, Carteret, Chowan, Columbus, Duplin, Edgecombe, Forsyth, Franklin, Greene, Harnett, Haywood, Iredell, Jackson, Johnston, Lee, Macon, Madison, Nash, Orange, Pasquotank, Pender, Richmond, Rowan, Sampson, Stanly, and Watauga Counties."

Sec. 2. G.S. 153A-158.1(b), as amended by Chapter 17 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"(b) Construction or Improvement by County. - A county may construct, equip, expand, improve, renovate, or otherwise make available property for use by a school administrative unit within the county. The local board of education shall be involved in

1 the design, construction, equipping, expansion, improvement, or renovation of the
2 property to the same extent as if the property were not financed under this section."

3 Sec. 3. Section 2 of this act applies only to Edgecombe, Greene, Jackson, and
4 Madison Counties.

5 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
