A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLAR EXCLUSION
2 LIMITATION ON CERTAIN PROPERTY FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING
3 ELIGIBILITY FOR THE STATE/COUNTY SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO ADULTS
4 PROGRAM.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 108A-41(c) reads as rewritten:

8 "(c) When determining whether a person has insufficient resources to provide a
9 reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, there shall be excluded from
10 consideration the person's primary place of residence and the land on which it is ~~situated,~~
11 ~~and in addition there shall be excluded real property contiguous with the person's primary place~~
12 ~~of residence in which the property tax value is less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000).~~
13 situated."

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to
15 determinations of eligibility made on or after that date.
