A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO GRANT THE TOWN OF APEX A TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM
THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF NONCONTIGUOUS TERRITORY THAT MAY BE
ANNEXED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) reads as rewritten:

"(5) The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added to the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed ~~ten percent (10%)~~ twenty percent (20%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the annexing city."

Sec. 2. This act only applies to the Town of Apex and only applies with respect to annexation ordinances adopted on or before December 31, 2000. This act does not apply to property in Chatham County; therefore, the Town of Apex may not annex property in Chatham County by satellite annexation if the area to be annexed, when added to the area within the satellite corporate limits of the Town of Apex, exceeds the limit set by general law in G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5).

Sec. 3. This act does not affect Section 3 of Chapter 312 of the 1993 Session Laws.

1 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
