1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A REFERENDUM ON THE REPEAL OF THE
3 CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SANDYFIELD.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Chapter 729 of the Session Laws of 1993 is repealed.

6 Sec. 2. Section 1 of this act becomes effective only if approved by the
7 qualified voters of the Town of Sandyfield in a referendum. The election shall be
8 conducted by the Columbus County Board of Elections on November 7, 1995. The
9 question on the ballot shall be:

10 "[] FOR [] AGAINST
11 INCORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SANDYFIELD".

12 Sec. 3. If a majority of the votes are cast AGAINST the question, then
13 effective upon the certification of the results of the election, Section 1 of this act becomes
14 effective, except that the governing board of the town as of the date of the election is
15 continued in office until January 1, 1996, for the sole purpose of liquidating the assets
16 and liabilities of the town and filing any financial reports that may be required by law. If
17 a majority of the votes are cast AGAINST the question, then the election of town officers
18 on that date is voided. Any net assets of the Town shall be paid over to Columbus
19 County, which shall use those funds for some public purpose in the area of the former
20 town.
