7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 87-88 is amended by adding a new section to read:
9	"(1) Exemption. – Any building constructed of concrete, metal, or other impervious
10	materials that do not produce chemicals or require treatment by chemicals is exempt from
11	the location requirements adopted by the Environmental Management Commission for
12	water supply wells regulated under this Article."
13	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
