March 30, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO HOSPICE FOR THE CAROLINAS, INC., FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF COST-EFFECTIVENESS AND OUTCOME STUDIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Hospice for the Carolinas, Inc., the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to perform cost-effectiveness and outcome studies of the hospice programs in North Carolina. Hospice for the Carolinas, Inc., shall make a progress report on its studies to the 1995 General Assembly, Regular Session 1996, and shall make a final

report to the 1997 General Assembly within one week of its convening.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
