A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE TAX CHECK-OFF FOR POLITICAL PARTIES AND
2 THE PUBLIC FINANCING OF CANDIDATES.

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4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Effective with respect to taxable years beginning on or after January
6 1, 1995, G.S. 105-159.1 is repealed.

7 Sec. 2. Effective January 1, 1997, Article 22B of Chapter 163 of the General
8 Statutes, constituting G.S. 163-278.41 through G.S. 163-278.43, is repealed.

9 Sec. 3. Effective with respect to taxable years beginning on or after January 1,
10 1995, G.S. 105-269.6 is repealed.

11 Sec. 4. Effective upon the ratification of this act, Article 22C of Chapter 163 of
12 the General Statutes, constituting G.S. 163-278.46 through G.S. 163-278.57, is repealed.

13 Sec. 5. Any funds held by the State Treasurer pursuant to G.S. 105-269.6 for
14 the North Carolina Candidates Financing Fund as of the ratification of this act shall be
15 transferred to the State Board of Elections for use in the administration of the election
16 laws of North Carolina. Any funds subsequently received by the State Treasurer pursuant
17 to G.S. 105-269.6 shall be transferred by the State Treasurer to the State Board of
18 Elections on a quarterly basis for use in the administration of the election laws of North
19 Carolina.

1 Sec. 6. This act is effective upon ratification.
